RELEASE - Resources that don't serve you:

- & Templates you printed but never used
- & Complex systems that created more work
- & Resources that don't match your student population
- & Outdated materials or discontinued programs

- & Duration recording tools
- & Interval recording sheets (whole/partial/momentary)
- & Latency recording forms
- & Scatter plot templates

2. Visual Supports Library

- & Visual schedules (daily/activity)
- & Calm down strategy cards
- & Choice boards
- & Social stories templates

3. Intervention Strategy Bank

- & Attention function interventions
- & Escape function interventions
- & Tangible function interventions
- & Sensory function interventions
- & Replacement behavior teaching protocols

4. Communication Templates

- & Parent communication logs
- & Behavior summary formats
- & IEP meeting data presentations
- & Progress notes templates

Summer Professional Development Priorities
